To qualify as a pathway partner, the NDSFA had to meet a strict set of criteria in regards to coaching philosophy, coaching qualifications, player trials and selections, etc that would enable us to support the Western Sydney Wanderers own philosophies and ethos.

An extension to this pathway is our Skills Acquisition Program. Our SAP players are also on this development pathway and our playing kits will have our shared pathway logo demonstrating the support from the Western Sydney Wanderers FC for our programs.

The Western Sydney Wanderers are proud to support the NDSFA and its representative body Nepean FC in these joint programs and all agreed that they look forward to a long, strong and mutually beneficial partnership.

The first of our Western Sydney Wanderers Pathway Programs is the Nepean Development Program commencing in Term 2.

These programs will be located at 3 venues across Penrith, Hawkesbury and the Blue Mountains to give maximum coverage to our players.
